The Cosplay event at Orlando Japan Festival is open to the public but in order to judge the costumes equally every cosplayer must abide by a basic list of guidelines:

Outfits should not be so revealing as to warrant indecent exposure charges. All body parts should be covered and not require constant pulling, tugging, straightening, etc. of the outfit to keep them covered. A good rule of thumb is to not wear anything that covers less than what you would wear to the pool or beach.

Orlando Japan Festival is a family event; while we understand that some cosplay characters wear more revealing outfits than others, you may be asked to "cover up" or modify your outfit in some way that is more modest in public areas. If you cannot follow this guideline, you will be disqualified.
